## REDUCE/REUSE/RECYCLE

## **REDUCE:**

Do you really need to buy all that stuff?!!

- Avoid buying bottled water the plastic bottles are a major source of pollution! Water in Cayman from the Water Authority or Cayman Water Company meets World Health Standards for safe drinking. Or use the 5 gallon water cooler bottles or the 'bottle-less' coolers (reverse osmosis).
- Think before printing! Print and copy double sided as far as possible
- Consider excess packaging, and number of small packages, bottles, tins, etc., versus larger 'containers', especially non-degradable material like plastics, before all purchases.
- Buy "Green" certified products especially for disposables, e.g. if you must use disposable plates, use paper
  that is environmentally friendly, instead of Styrofoam and plastic and such, and use similar precautions for
  environmentally friendly detergents, etc.
- Reduce electricity consumption see separate flyer from DoE.

## **REUSE:**

Be creative! Not just with water containers, plates, cups, etc. But look for ways to reuse containers you could not avoid when purchasing a product – like plastics – or bottles and even paper, in all sorts of creative ways. There are many ideas for this in craft books, on the Internet, etc. Hopefully by now everyone is using *reusable shopping bags*. But if you find yourself with a plastic bag, reuse it for garbage or such.

## **RFCYCLF:**



SEPARATE AND RECYCLE PLASTIC (look for the recyclable logo) AND ALUMINUM – and other metals – at JUNK Recyclers Ltd (including damaged plastic and metal chairs, old computers, etc, that our churches produce a lot of!)

Glass can now be recycled in Cayman too – check for currently available facilities for this, e.g. by Dart Group at Camana Bay.

Think first! If it can be recycled, please don't dump it!
