KNOW YOUR UCJCI CONSTITUTION

Visitation of Congregations

The **Regional Mission Council** shall have the power to visit Congregations within its bounds:

a) As a means of showing interest in and imparting stimulus to Church life and work, the Regional Mission Council shall **at least once every three years visit**, by deputation or otherwise, the Congregations within its bounds. They shall confer with the **Minister**, the **Congregational Board**, and with such organisations as are closely identified with the life and work of the Congregations. They shall consult with the **Congregations** and shall address such counsel and encouragement as may be suitable in the circumstances.

b) At each visitation, full inquiry shall be made into the **condition, efficiency and progress** of the Congregation, having due regard to all departments of Ministerial, Congregational, and mission work.

A **brief report** embodying the results of the visitation shall be prepared, a copy of which shall be sent to the Congregational Board and read to the Congregation.
