KNOW YOUR UCJCI CONSTITUTION

SYNOD

and

CENTRAL MISSION COUNCIL

There shall be a **Synod** whose membership shall consist of the members of The Regional Mission Councils or their accredited alternates. The Synod shall be the **supreme legislative and administrative body** of the Church and shall meet biennially. Its business shall be presided over by a **Moderator**, who shall be elected biennially, with the possibility of one additional term. The Synod shall administer its affairs through the **Synodical Committees**. There shall be a convention-type meeting in between the meetings of Synod.

There shall be a **Central Mission Council** appointed by Synod to consist of the Moderator, General Secretary, Chairpersons of Regional Mission Councils, Secretaries of Regional Mission Councils, Treasurer, Chairperson of each Committee, one representative from each Regional Mission Council, which shall see to the implementation of decisions and plans of Synod.
