POPULAR REPORT cont.

- DATA PROTECTION LAW 2017 This was discussed, and Council members were asked to ensure that the law is adhered to at the Congregational level. The RDGS was tasked with ensuring that training for Council members was done in conjunction with the Office of the Ombudsman.
- STRATEGIC DEVELOPMENT TASK FORCE: Council approved the motion to create a strategic development taskforce. The team will be named by Council Executive
- COUNCIL'S GROUP WORK Three groups were identified to discuss the following areas of the Council's ministry: Leadership, Evangelism and Discipleship. Lively discussions were held in each group and the reports will be made available to Council shortly.
- FINANCIAL REPORT: Mr. Ronnie Dunn of FINCOR presented the 2nd Quarter 2019 financial report and it was approved by Council.
