## The CIRMC's Response to the Ukraine Crisis

The Congregations in the Cayman Islands Regional Mission Council received financial donations from Members and Adherents from March to May 2022 to provide relief in war-torn Ukraine.

On Wednesday, June 29, 2022, the Regional Deputy General Secretary, Rev Dr Yvette Noble-Bloomfield, presented CI \$ 7,782.40 to the Cayman Islands Red Cross. Mrs. Samantha White-Smith, the CIRC Volunteer and Resources Manager, accepted the cheque on behalf of the CIRC. The CIRC will send the funds to the Ukraine Red Cross to support the continuing relief effort.

We remain in prayer for the people of Ukraine.
