## For Your Prayerful Support

This is indeed a very sad time for the United Church; a time that signals the transition that is taking place. We have lost two more dedicated servants of God and the United Church.

Rev. Stanford Webley passed away on January 26, 2017. Rev. Webley was an excellent leader and served as Secretary and Chairman of the Congregational Union and as Moderator of the United Church in Jamaica and the Cayman Islands. An ecumenist, Rev. Webley served the Jamaica Council of Churches for over 12 years, holding offices of Executive Secretary and Chairman. He also served as Vice-Moderator of the International Congregational Council. For his outstanding service in the field of religion, the Jamaican Government awarded him the Order of Distinction, Officer Class in 1975.

Rev. Winston Derrick Barrett transitioned this life on the early morning of January 27, 2017. He gave outstanding leadership to the Richmond Road (St. Mary), First Hill (Trelawny) and Savanna-lar-mar (Westmoreland) Charges during his ministry and in the Cayman Council where he served his internship. In 2014 he was honoured by the Savanna la mar Charge (where he last served for 28 years), when the Church hall was renamed in his honour. 2017 marks the 53<sup>rd</sup> year of his Ordination to the Ministry of Word and Sacraments.
