
John was a faithful servant of God, whose dedication, diligence and commitment were gifts to the church.

#### WHAT IS SYNOD?

Synod is the biennial gathering of the leadership of the church to discern and strategize for the church's mission. The Synod is the decision-making body of the church and is comprised of:

The Moderator, General Secretary, Deputy General Secretaries, Ministers (Ordained and Commissioned), Ministerial Students, Lay Pastors, Elders (selected to represent their congregations), Staff, and Chairpersons of Standing Committees (Strategic Planning, Church and Ministry, Constitution and Doctrine, Property, Finance).

When Synod meets, we will be exploring our understanding of God's vision and purpose for the UCJCI over the next two years. We will be doing this, drawing on the delegates'

experience of our Church in the past against the background of the theme and the contexts in which we live.

The visioning process itself will concentrate on the future, taking into consideration the challenges being faced due to the impact of COVID-19 pandemic which has swept the globe and is significantly impacting life in general. In preparation to the 43<sup>rd</sup> Synod, the delegates were invited to consider the following:

1. How do we Worship, Nurture and Train? (models of the worshipping church, reaching all our members, nurture, technology, and Lay Training)

2.How do we Witness - How does and how should the Church respond? Consider areas such as Education, Economic Needs, Housing, Food Security and Family Life.

3. How do we Work efficiently? (finances, meetings, etc.)

4. How do we weave Evangelism in the ways in which we Worship, Nurture and Witness?

### THEME FOCUS

During the Synod the delegates will explore the theme in Bible Studies. This will be done in a participatory way using the Zoom platform and delegates will have the opportunity to engage the theme and related texts in discussion. As we vision for the future, our theme must play a critical role in impacting how we function.

Delegates will share their local experiences (characteristics, challenges, celebrations, opportunities – taking in the social, economic, political, theological, cultural). It is expected that the Bible studies will bring the voice of the Bible to our individual contexts so that we can plan and take concrete action that will be relevant.

## THE ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DELEGATES

The delegates

- represent their congregation and its views
- should participate in the decision making
- should attend all events at which you need to make representation
- should pay attention to information presented to you
- should participate in the discussions so that your opinions are heard
- should inform their congregation of the outcomes of Synod
- should remind their congregation to follow up decisions

Mon. – Realign Our Worship

Tue. – Reconnect our Relationship with Children and Youth

Wed. – Re-ignite our Stewardship and Leadership

Thu. - Return to Discipleship


