Re-Ignited to Deepened Faith - Overcoming by the Power of God's Spirit

1 Samuel 17:19-23), 32-49; Psalm 9:9-20;
2 Corinthians 6:1-13; Mark 4:35-41

Remember that those who know God's name put their trust in God. When the going got tough, David was not overwhelmed by the size and capacity of the Philistine warriors. He opted to focus on God's power, which had been tried and tested in 'life and death' situations in the wilderness. Our Faith is deepened when we overcome trials in the wildernesses of life (2 Corinthians 6) by purity, knowledge, patience, kindness, holiness of spirit, and genuine love, which is born of God's Spirit. Having overcome these obstacles, we are equipped to face even greater enemies.

David did not try to be a warrior like Saul; the armor would not fit. Instead, under the Power of God's Spirit,

David used the weapons with which he was accustomed. Recognize that we are also called to fight in 'our' character under the anointing and power of God's Spirit.
