CAYMAN'S ECUMENICAL SERVICE FOR 'CANDIDATES'.

he Cayman Islands
Regional Mission
Council in conjunction
with the Cayman Islands
Ministers' Association and the
Cayman Islands Conference
of Seventh Day Adventists
held a joint Worship Service
for the Candidates seeking
to be elected to the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman
Islands.

The General Elections will be held on **Wednesday**, **May 24**, **2017**.

The Service was held on Sunday May 7, 2017 at the Elmslie Memorial Church and was attended by forty-eight (48) of the sixty one (61) Candidates. The service was also attended by a wide cross section of the Cayman population. Each Candidate received a Bible from the United Church and a flash drive with the crucial documents of the Cayman Ministers Association including the Code of Conduct for Candidates and the Fort Street Declaration on Marriage.

Several denominations were represented and the Clergy assisted with the placing of the Bible and flash drive in each Candidate's hand.



Rev. Dr. Davidson's sermon, based on Proverbs 14:24-34 and Matthew 6:31-34, carried the theme, 'The Secret of a Great Nation',

The Sermon was nuanced in the following manner:

Point # 1 God's Word Declares that Government is Necessary to Maintain Justice and Order,

Point # 2 God's Word Indicates that a Nation Needs Vigilant Citizens, and

Point # 3 God's Word Calls Leaders and Citizens to Seek after Righteousness First. It was timely, instructive and well received. Thanks have been expressed by the Region to all who participated in the Service but we are grateful to God for the Word and Spirit's presence.

The Swanky Kitchen Band provided special Praise in the heritage of the Cayman Islands' musical genre.

It was well received.
